Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by Penny Douglas, Chairman

Welcome & Introductions

Announcements:

- Pooches in the Green – occurring on Saturday 03/20/2010, 11:00 AM – 2:30 PM @ Beaverton's City Park (across from Beaverton Library).
- Henry Kane announced he is running for City Councilor seat vacated by Councilor Dalrymple.

Beaverton Police Department:

Office Michael P. Smith reported:

- Graffiti has still been an issue in the area, but they are continuing work to crack down on it.
- There has been some theft from vehicles reported. Officer Smith recommended to everyone to not leave any valuables in their car.
- The Beaverton Police Department recently had a prescription drug turn-in event (on 03/18/10) where they collected 200 lbs. of expired prescription medication. This was considered a great success.
- A New Uniform Committee has been formed for Beaverton PD, so there may be slight modifications to the uniforms over the next several months.

Approval of previous Vose NAC meeting minutes:

The meeting minutes from 02/18/2010 were approved by unanimous consent.

Treasurer Report:

Treasurer Christopher Redmond was not present, so Penny Douglas subbed in and reported that the current balance of the Vose NAC bank account is unchanged and remains at \$1,032.22.

Beaverton Committee for Citizen Involvement (BCCI) Report:

Henry Kane (BCCI Alt. Representative) reported:

- The City of Beaverton has formed the Beaverton Urban Renewal Agency.
- TC 666 had been struck down so there will be no striping of bike lanes or restricting of parking along Lombard Street at this time.
- The builders for a construction project on Sabin had not filed for an extension, so the project must be restarted if they want to proceed.

Old/New Business

- Penny Douglas reported further on the Beaverton Urban Renewal Agency. She emphasized the need for our NAC to stay informed on any action pursued by this agency.
- Jerry Noble reported on the events from the NAC Leadership Meeting that occurred on 03/04/10.
- There was a discussion about the need for a crosswalk on Lombard Street somewhere between 5th Street & Allen Blvd. The possibility of forming a sub-committee to work on this issue was raised.

Open Forum

- There was a continued discussion regarding the pros and cons of bike lanes along Lombard Street.
- The Beaverton Urban Renewal Agency was also discussed, and it was encouraged for NAC members to research the outcomes of other cities' urban renewal projects.
