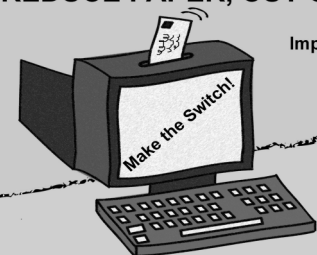

For this specific ZMA, the proposal is to amend the Zoning Map to delete the obsolete Office Commercial (OC) zone and apply the Community Service (CS) and/or Neighborhood Service Center (NS) zones. The subject site is a developed area, consisting of four (4) parcels. No new development is proposed as a part of this application.</p>
