# Beaverton's Recycling Day Saturday, June 2 (9 – 2 pm)

Each year, Beaverton's Neighborhood Association Committees (NACs) partner with the City, the Beaverton Committee for Citizen Involvement (BCCI), and several recycling vendors to help the community recycle items not taken at the curb. This free event requires dozens of volunteers to primarily help people unload their cars, but there are a limited number of "low impact" jobs available as well.

- **Two volunteer shifts** (Last year each shift worked raised \$48 for your NAC.)
  - 8 am to 12 pm
  - 11 am to 3 pm
- The money is used by your neighborhood to **fund great projects and events throughout the year.**
- **Anyone can volunteer who is 16 years of age or older.** Those under 18 will need to have a parent or guardian complete a waiver.
