Meeting was called to order at 7:03 PM. Introductions were made.

Beaverton Police Department – Officer White reminded all to watch out for children on Halloween night. The current city hall will be remodeled to house the Police Department and municipal court. An architect has been hired to design the space. A question was asked about gangs in Beaverton. A group of young kids and late teens, known as the Knight Owls are active, but mainly create graffiti. Their tag is KOS. Medical Marijuana Dispensaries may be coming. These often bring crime into the area. Currently there is a methadone clinic near city hall and this has caused problems with patients selling their prescription on the street are dosing nearby.

Tualatin Valley Fire & Rescue was not available due to an emergency call.

Open Discussion

Discussed Matching Grant Program through the city. Penny says families at the Vose Neighborhood picnic asked about getting school supplies. This may be something we should look into next year. Tree plantings and benches were discussed as well.
