

The redevelopment involves the removal of the basketball court and the construction of a new picnic shelter, pedestrian bridge, stormwater swale, screened portable restrooms and a boardwalk over the wetlands. Renovation of the existing play equipment is also proposed. Removal of approximately 28% of the DBH (Diameter at Breast Height) of surveyed non-exempt trees within Significant Grove 10 (#G10) is proposed to improve the habitat for the Oregon White Oak. The location of the proposed redevelopment is at the west end of SW Marjorie Lane/ SW 105th Avenue.</p>
