**BEAVERTON, Ore.** – The Beaverton City Library will host “Starting Your Own Vegetable Garden” on Tuesday, March 15, at 7 p.m. at 12375 SW Fifth Street. OSU Extension Service Master Gardener Sal Bianco will talk to participants about the process of creating a lush, productive vegetable garden.

Bianco will focus on spring and summer vegetable gardens. He will talk about site selection, soil preparation, planting times, water and fertilization needs, and general garden maintenance.
