#### **Calling All Visual Artists! – The How-To’s of Applying for Our 2016 Beaverton Arts Mix! Juried Art Show, Thursday, June 30**

This workshop will include a step by step introduction to Submittable, an online interface that will be used this year for artwork submissions. Professional photographer and trainer Rebecca Benoit will teach tricks of the trade for photographing your art and proper editing techniques to make your art stand out to a professional jury panel. Artists are encouraged to bring their laptops and other technology to follow along, as well as their artwork.
