WASHINGTON COUNTY INVITES PROPOSALS FOR SMALL ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

-Proposals due July 15-

BEAVERTON, Ore. – The public is invited to propose roadways in the Washington County area for small-scale improvements through the Washington County Department of Land Use & Transportation. Currently, 12 percent of Beaverton’s roads are county-owned and maintained.

Proposed improvements must address safety or connectivity issues on a county road. To submit a proposal, review the county’s [map of identified small road improvement candidates](#). To propose a new roadway, submit an [online form](#) or contact the operations and maintenance division at 503-846-ROAD (7623) or email lutops@co.washington.or.us. Supporting documents are encouraged, such as photos, maps, and letters of community support.

Proposals must be received by Friday, July 15 and will be considered later this year by the Urban Road Maintenance District (URMD) Advisory Committee for the URMD Safety Improvement program. Roadways not selected for funding remain on the list for future consideration.
