APPLY NOW FOR DIVERSE ART OFFERINGS GRANT

BEAVERTON, Ore. – The City of Beaverton’s Arts Program is accepting applications for the diverse art offerings grant program.

This program supports unexpected art opportunities or events. Projects could include workshops, art classes, or art activities that serve Beaverton residents. This program is intended to support rare or unexpected opportunities, especially for emerging artists, students, and organizations new to the grant application process.

Students, individual artists, and arts and culture organizations who serve the Beaverton community are eligible to apply, as well as Beaverton schools and libraries.

Grants may be awarded up to \$500 per event or opportunity, or until all funds are expended. Only one request per individual or organization will be funded each calendar year. Recipients of 2016 Beaverton community art grants are not eligible for this program.

Applications will be accepted through Dec. 31. All funded activities must take place within the 2016 calendar year and must serve Beaverton residents.
