FARMINGTON RD AND MURRAY BLVD INTERSECTION WEEKEND WORK SCHEDULED IN OCTOBER

BEAVERTON, Ore. – Weekend work will begin on Friday, Oct. 21 to Sunday, Oct. 23, and Friday, Oct. 28 to Sunday, Oct. 30 at the intersection of SW Farmington Road and SW Murray Blvd (weather permitting). The weekend work is estimated to take place from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Flaggers will be present. Night work has been extended to Friday, Nov. 18 to complete the installation of storm drains and water lines.

Work at the Farmington and Murray intersection includes installing upgraded sanitary sewer, storm drainage and water lines. During the weekend of Oct. 21 to 23 the outside lanes on westbound and eastbound on Farmington will be closed. During the weekend of Oct. 28 to 30, the inside lanes on westbound and eastbound Farmington will be closed and left hand turns from westbound Farmington will be restricted.

Vehicles and bicyclists are urged to use alternate routes including SW Allen Blvd or SW Tualatin-Valley Highway. The map below highlights the area of night work.

The joint project between Beaverton and Washington County is scheduled for completion by late spring 2017. Improvements include:

- Widening Farmington Road to five lanes (two lanes in each direction and a center turn lane) between Murray Blvd and Hocken Ave
- Installing bicycle lanes, sidewalks and street lighting
- Realigning 141st and 142nd Avenues
- Upgrading water and sanitary sewer lines

The first phase of the Farmington Project—the widening of the south side of Farmington including the installation of a new box culvert at Erickson Creek—has been completed. The second phase which includes the sewer line installation is nearing completion. Private utilities are currently relocating their facilities on the north side of Farmington. After the relocation, work including curb, sidewalks and paving will occur.

The third phase includes widening the north side of Farmington Road. The final phase which includes improvements to the Farmington Road and Murray Boulevard intersection will occur mostly at night.
