BEAVERTON CITY LIBRARY HOSTS 14TH ANNUAL TEEN ART SHOW

BEAVERTON, Ore. – Beaverton City Library and the Teen Library Council invite the community to the 14th Annual Teen Art Show at the main library, 12375 SW Fifth St. The opening reception will be held Wednesday, Nov. 9, from 4 to 5 p.m. and features light refreshments, musical performances by local teens and the first chance to vote for the People's Choice Award.

The show remains open the public Thursday, Nov. 10, Saturday, Nov. 12 and Sunday, Nov. 13 during library hours. The library is closed Friday, Nov. 11 for Veterans Day.

Area teens in grades 6-12 are encouraged to submit up to two artworks for consideration in the exhibition. Teachers can submit artwork on Thursday, Nov. 3; students and parents can submit artwork on Friday, Nov. 4, and Saturday, Nov. 5. Artwork can be brought to the Teen Room at the main library.

There will be two \$100 gift certificates for Blick Art Materials for the two winners of the People's Choice Award (middle school and high school divisions). The winners will be chosen by show attendees. A \$100 gift certificate to Blick will also go to the middle school and high school art departments with the most artists submitting works. The four awards are sponsored by the New Friends of the Beaverton City Library and Blick.
