BEAVERTON HOLDS POP-UP ENERGY AND LIGHTING FAIR

BEAVERTON, Ore. – The City of Beaverton invites residents to save energy and money at a one-day, pop-up lighting event on Wednesday, Nov. 9 from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. at Beaverton City Library Main, 12375 SW Fifth St.

The event features the chance to purchase greatly-discounted energy-efficient light bulbs for your home or business. Energy-saving kits including six long-lasting LED light bulbs and one water-efficient showerhead will be available for \$10 each. Other energy-saving bulbs for track, recessed, standard and specialty lighting fixtures are priced beginning at \$5. Cash, check and charge will be accepted. Supplies are limited.

Residential LEDs, especially ENERGY STAR rated products, use at least 75 percent less energy and last 25 times longer than incandescent lighting. Widespread use of LED lighting has the greatest potential impact on energy savings in the United States.

The city is committed to environmental responsibility and raising sustainability awareness among our residents and community members. Decreasing greenhouse gas emissions, increasing the use of renewable energy sources, reducing waste and conserving water are just a few of the city's key focus areas.
