VANEK'S SHOE REPAIR CELEBRATES NEW LOOK WITH RIBBON CUTTING

BEAVERTON, Ore. – The City of Beaverton will hold a ribbon cutting celebrating Vanek's Shoe Repair's new look on Thursday, Nov. 17, from 4 to 5 p.m. at 124650 SW Broadway St. The downtown Beaverton business will unveil its new signs, windows and door, exterior brick, window display area, and more.

Vanek's received a storefront design services grant from the city in Sept. 2015. The business worked with a city-selected architect, Ascent Architecture, to create an affordable design highlighting its shoe repair and retail services. They also received a 50/50 matching storefront improvement grant in March 2016 for the project. Local contractor Feinauer and Sons worked on the project.

Refreshments will be provided at the ribbon cutting. No RSVP is required.

Through Beaverton Community Vision, people said they wanted to support local businesses and beautify downtown areas.
