Meeting Minutes

Committee Members Present: Patricia Longua, Richard Eyde, Ryan Hoppes, Laura Mitchell, Lisa Stiller, Erin Woolley, Abdul Samad Ghaznavi and staff liaison Megan Cohen.

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. Megan provided an update regarding the presentation schedule and went over ground rules for the dedicated ten minutes for question and answer. Megan kept time for presenting organizations.

HomePlate Youth Services: Bridget Calfee (ED) presented HomePlate's \$20,000 request for outreach support. Grant funds will be used for expanding outreach to Beaverton homeless youth through recruitment and training of community volunteers. Funding will support personnel and youth support expenses.

Sunshine Pantry: No call / no show.

Viva Village (Villages NW): Larry Brown and Kathe Fradkin (Governing Council Co-Chairs) and Don Wolf presented Viva Village's \$3,258 request for providing low-income seniors access to the program and enable them to live in their own homes independently. Funds will subsidize membership fees for six seniors as well as provide for volunteer background checks and program administration.

Just Compassion of East Washington County: Donna Krauthoefer and Sue Stephens presented Just Compassion's \$20,000 request to support a day center for homeless adults. Funds will be used to pay for personnel expenses associated with running the shelter.

Meals on Wheels People: Vicki Adams (Beaverton Center Manager) presented Meals on Wheels' \$8,000 request for the Beaverton Senior Nutrition Program. This program provides food to seniors who would otherwise have no access to fresh, healthy food. Funds will be used to purchase food for the program.

Immigrant Refugee Community Organization: Hassan Ali (Somali Bantu Citizens Group) and Abdiasis Mohamed (IRCO/ Africa House Operation Manager) presented a \$20,000 request for a culturally and linguistically-specific afterschool program. Funds will support personnel expenses, childcare for workshops, client assistance, and associated operational expenses.

The meeting adjourned at 8 p.m. The next meeting will be held on Tuesday, April 19 at 5:30 pm in the 3rd Floor Tualatin River Room of The Beaverton Building.
