### Agenda

- NAC Chair, Carl Tebbe called the meeting to order at 7:04, which was followed by introductions of all in attendance. Neither Beaverton Police nor TVF&R were available.
- Sabrina Taylor Schmitt updated members on activities planned by the park district during the spring time, and supplied written news releases detailing this information. She mentioned that there is no change in the schedule to develop the “greenhouse property park”, which is proposed for 2018-19. Residents vying for open Board seats on THPRD’s Board will be at the April 18 NAC meeting. Questions & answers of Sabrina followed.
- Lisa McCurdy presented attendees with Costco’s programs and products, emphasizing a number of products that she brought along, including a 72-hour emergency kit. She described the benefits of membership. Questions & answers of Lisa followed.
- Gini Peterson from Washington County Community Action described the goals and programs of this non-profit social service agency. They target families in poverty with programs to assist children, new mothers, homeless and at-risk families, among others. Ms. Peterson played a video illustrating how their programs assist those in need. The organization’s Annual Report was distributed. Questions & answers for Gini followed.
- Terry Lawler updated the group on the most recent BCCI meeting held Feb. 27. Information on the new performing arts center (still raising funds), the dates for
