Southwest Farmington and Murray road construction slated to be complete in July

When will this thing be done? That's what commuters ask every day about the road work and construction underway at Southwest Farmington Road and Murray Boulevard.

According to Beaverton Public Involvement and Communications Manager Holly Thompson, the answer to that question is, early July.

Right now, the sidewalk is in the process of being poured — starting at the south end and heading toward Southwest Tualatin Valley Highway.

The project, which was started in April 2015, was slated to be complete before July, but inclement weather contributed to delays with the many snowstorms and days of rain.

Also a factor in delaying the process was the moving of utilities and work on the water and sewer lines, which are all now upgraded and underground, Thompson said.

When the project is complete, both sides of Southwest Murray Boulevard and Farmington Road will be widened and sidewalks will be added.

City of Beaverton staff acknowledges that the road construction was wearing thin on residents' patience, but predicted the improvements will be well-received by both pedestrians and drivers.
