Meeting Minutes

Committee Members Present: Patricia Longua, Richard Eyde, Ryan Hoppes, Laura Mitchell, Lisa Stiller, Erin Woolley, and staff liaison Megan Cohen.

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. Megan provided an update regarding the presentation schedule and kept time for presenting organizations.

Assistance League of Greater Portland: Carol Bray and Allison Mudrick presented the organization's request for \$8,000 to support the Operation School Bell Program. The funds would be used to provide new school clothing for preschool and elementary children and a shopping opportunity for middle and high school children to buy new clothes for school or athletic activities.

St. Cecilia/St. Vincent de Paul: Mona Stahl and Kathy Johnson presented the organization's request for \$20,000 to provide emergency rental assistance for Beaverton residents and prevent eviction. 100% of the funds would be used for rental assistance.

Meals on Wheels People: Jay Gilbertson presented the organization's request for \$8,000 to provide hot, daily meals to older adults in the Beaverton area at the Elsie Stuhr center and delivery to homebound seniors. 100% of the funds would be used to purchase food for the program.

Beaverton Education Foundation: Kristine Baggett, Lawrence Gil, and a student in the program presented the organization's request for \$30,000 to the Safe and Sound 4 Student Success Program. The program provides afterschool academic support combined with athletics (soccer) to at-risk middle school students. Funds would be used for healthy snacks, transportation, coaches, and teachers in providing the program.

Westside Service Center: Patti Jensen presented the organization's request for \$5,000 to supporting a safe and sober space for individuals going through peer-based 12 step recovery programs. Funds would be used to sustain recovery activities as the organization works to diversify its funding sources and develop greater sustainability.

Tualatin Riverkeepers: Mike Skuja and Charissa Jones presented the organization's request for \$20,000 to support the position of Environmental Educator. The position would lead field trips, summer camps, and community events with Beaverton residents to connect them to the Tualatin River and nature in the area.

The meeting adjourned at 8:20 p.m. The next meeting will be held on Monday, May 1 at 5:30 pm in the 1st Floor Fanno Creek Room of The Beaverton Building.
