### Meeting Minutes

**Committee Members Present:** Patricia Longua, Laura Mitchell, Lisa Stiller, Erin Woolley, Abdul Ghaznavi, Tiffany Burton, student liaison Maya Bedge, staff liaison Megan Cohen.

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. Megan provided an update regarding the presentation schedule and kept time for presenting organizations. Laura made a motion to disqualify Assistance League from the process for not attending the interview. Erin seconded and the motion passed with four votes in favor and Lisa Stiller abstaining.

Oregon Food Bank: Maggie Bonjean and Jen Turner presented the organization's request for \$10,000 to collect and distribute food to hungry community members. Funds support OFB in providing food, training, and technical support to partner agencies.

Teens Finding Hope: Kristi Barth presented the organization's request for \$3,100 to support a citywide event for teens and family members affected by depression in September 2018, including a teen mental health expert providing strategies, resources, and workshops to teens. Grant fund pay for the resource books that are distributed.

Bridge Meadows: Derenda Schubert and Renee Moseley presented the organization's request for \$15,000 to support the intergenerational housing community serving foster children, parents, and elders. Funding supports a Community Support Specialist position.

Voices Set Free: Louise Bauschard presented the organization's request for \$20,000 to implement a childhood domestic violence intervention program with the Family Justice Center. Funding supports clinical staff and supervision of three social work interns.

Lutheran Community Services NW: Stephanie Green Weizer presented the organization's request for \$20,000 to support programming that guides refugee and immigrant students through adjustment and acculturation in partnership with Beaverton High School. Funding goes towards staff salaries, supplies, and translation.

Community Action: Susan Salisbury and Katharine Galian presented the organization's request for \$15,000 to fund a Housing Specialist dedicated to landlord outreach in Beaverton, encouraging involvement with Eviction Prevention/Rapid Rehousing.

Daytime Enrichment Activities & Recreation: Dave Apple presented the organization's request for \$10,000 to provide care to individuals who are disabled/medically fragile. Funding supplements the salary for a bookkeeper and facilities manager.

Adelante Mujeres: Andrea Chunga-Cellis presented the organization's request for \$10,000 to support a culturally competent afterschool program for leadership development and academic success of Latina youth, in grades 3-12. Funding goes towards staff salaries for the four Chicas facilitators in Beaverton.

The meeting adjourned at 8:50 p.m. The next meeting will be held on Wednesday, May 2 at 5:30 pm in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor Tualatin River Room of The Beaverton Building.
