Meeting Minutes

Committee Members Present: Patricia Longua, Laura Mitchell, Lisa Stiller, Abdul Ghaznavi, Tiffany Burton, and staff liaison Megan Cohen.

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. Megan provided an update regarding the presentation schedule and kept time for presenting organizations. Impact NW withdrew their application from the process and did not attend the interview.

Holy Trinity Catholic Church: Al Schmitt presented the organization's request for \$20,000 to support the backpack program that send home food for hungry families in the Beaverton School District. 100% of the funding is used to purchase food.

Meals on Wheels People: Jay Gilbertson presented the organization's request for \$8,000 to provide daily meals to older adults in the Beaverton area at the Elsie Stuhr Center and delivery to homebound seniors. Funds will be used to purchase food.

Kinship House: Dennise M. Kowalczyk presented the organization's request for \$20,000 to provide outpatient mental health services to foster children/families in partnership with Bridge Meadows. Funding goes towards therapy tools and staff salaries.

Youth Contact: Judy Harris presented the organization's request for \$16,000 to provide school-based and outpatient behavioral health programs to youth and families in the Beaverton School District, ensuring they develop healthy behaviors, receive enrollment assistance with OHP, and connect to resources. Funds would support personnel.

Virginia Garcia Memorial Health Center: Kyle Allen presented the organization's request for \$20,000 to offer culturally appropriate community dental care for underserved elementary and middle school students in the Beaverton School District. Funding goes towards salaries and supplies for the on-site sealant dental team.

Community Warehouse: Dunetchka Otero presented the organization's request for \$10,000 to provide delivery service of essential furnishing to neighbors in need. Funding goes towards delivery fees and truck maintenance.

St. Cecilia/St. Vincent de Paul: Mona Stahl presented the organization's request for \$20,000 to provide emergency rent assistance for Beaverton residents needing to keep their rent paid to prevent eviction.

St. Matthew Lutheran Church's Special Church/Community Action Team: Joanne Dunatchik presented the organization's request for \$10,000 to provide pantry/food delivery services to Beaverton households. 100% of the funds would be used to purchase food.

The meeting adjourned at 9:00 p.m. The next meeting will be held on Wednesday, May 9 at 6 pm in the 3rd Floor Tualatin River Room of The Beaverton Building.
