Councilman Bruce Dalrymple presented information on the feasibility of constructing a multi-purpose facility to accommodate the Triple AAA Portland Beavers Baseball Team. It will be done step by step. \$6000 has been authorized for an appraisal of a possible location site.

**Habitat for Humanity Hunnting Park 5 Lot Subdivision** report by Henry Kane –

Mr. Kane reviewed the planning department files and believes there are required files missing. He submitted a letter, for review at the July 29<sup>th</sup> Planning Commission meeting. Mr. Kane testified at the August 5<sup>th</sup> Planning Committee meeting and briefly discussed LUBA requirements. He asked for a Continuance. The Continuance was denied. Mr. Kane moved to keep the record open for seven days, it was approved. The subdivision was approved by the Planning Commission.

Mr. Kane said that this is the time to file an appeal. Larry Fleming said he was not willing to go forward with an appeal at this time. The group wants to get feedback from Chris Redmond, Vose NAC Chairman, before moving forward.

**Vose NAC Picnic and Bicycle Parade** will be held September 12, 2009. The bicycle parade starts at Ridgecrest Park and ends at Wonderland Park.

**Neighborhood Concerns**
