Meeting called to order by Christopher Redmond, Chairman at 7:00 PM.

Hunting Park, A Habitat for Humanity Project

Presentation by Kirsten VanLoo, SFA Design Group, LLC

The 5 lot subdivision, located on Sussex Street at Hall Blvd., has been submitted for completion review. The statutory requirements have been met. The land use application has been submitted for adjustment and variance for the depth and width of the lots. Current zoning is R2 for 2000 Sq Ft lots, the proposal is to change it to unattached single family residence. The Beaverton Development Code is contradictory and therefore needs approval. Hopefully approval will be given in July 2009.

The development will be using a new style of water treatment. There will be bio-filtration boxes for storm water run off in each front yard. This system is environmentally sound and low impact.

The homes will be 800 to 1200 sq ft and will have at least 1 off street parking spot. There are no garages for Habitat for Humanity homes.

Meeting Minutes -- Penny presented the minutes of the February and March meetings. Henry Kane motioned to accept the February minutes as read. It was seconded and passed to approve the February minutes.

Old Business (Matching Grant) – Bikes for Kids – Vose School May 30, 2009

Vose NAC members have collected old unused bicycles and delivered them to WashCo BTC, at the Frans Pauwels Memorial Community Bicycle Center, for repair. A total of 16 bikes have been donated towards the Vose NAC collection. Volunteers have helped clean, dismantle, and repair bicycles. Repair volunteer night is Tuesdays from 6 PM to 9 PM at WashCo BTC. Repairs are also being done by the TNT (Tandemonium) bicycle group. TNT offered to donate all of the helmets at the event on May 30th at Vose Elementary School. The children will get proper fitting of the helmets and get bicycle safety training. Afterwards we will have a bicycle fun ride and then a light lunch. Volunteers are needed to set up at 9:00 AM and help with the children when they start arriving about 10:00 AM.
