Tualatin Valley Fire & Rescue Report (Station 53): The station has been very busy this fall; they've had over 1200 calls more than this time last year.

The district is celebrating the 30th anniversary of the station on 139th with an open house on Saturday, Oct. 19 from 10-2. All are invited and you can see their new fire trucks.

Safety reminders: Pull to the right when an emergency vehicle is approaching; this has been better lately but continues to be an issue. As you start to burn wood this fall, be careful of chimney fires; don't forget to open your flue before you light a fire and get your chimney serviced if it hasn't been serviced recently. Remember that barbecues are not supposed to be used inside the house or inside closed garages. Make sure your CO2 detectors are up to date and it's time to check your smoke detector. Wash your hands (it's that season!).

All TVF&R stations are open 24/7, and you're welcome to visit and bring your kids for a tour. There will be someone there unless the crew is on a call.

Beaverton Police Department Report: Officer Justin Haugen noted that the crime statistics didn't change much from last month. Upcoming events sponsored by the department:

- Document shredding, Oct. 12 from 10-1 at Sunset Presbyterian Church on Cornell. The limit is 3 boxes of documents per vehicle.
- Car seat clinic, Oct. 19 from 9-11:30 at Kuni Auto Center on Cedar Hills Blvd.; no appointment is necessary.
- DEA Drug takeback, Oct. 26 from 9-2 at the Police Dept., where you can turn in your unused prescription medications.

The police chief position should be announced shortly; the finalists have already been interviewed. The department recently had testing for sergeants and lieutenants in anticipation of retirements. They also had night range training at TriCounty gun range; range training happens 4-5 times per year.
