### **Refuse Collection and Recycling in West Slope:**

#### **Angie DeRouche – Agilyx**

Agilyx accepts polystyrene products marked as #6 or PS. Includes Expanded Polystyrene (EPS) such as Styrofoam packing, ice chests; General Purpose Polystyrene (GPPS) such as clear eating utensils, plates and cups; High Impact Polystyrene (HIPS) such as non-transparent cups and plates; and Extruded Polystyrene (XPS) like food containers and meat trays Their facility is located at 13240 SW Wall Street, Tigard near SW 72<sup>nd</sup> and HWY 217 and is open 24/7. Follow directions on the bins. Agilyx has developed a process to breakdown the polystyrene into styrene feedstock which is used to make new products.

#### **John Romero – West Slope Garbage Services (WSGS)**

Recycling efforts have become more difficult since the Chinese economy slowed down and they are no longer buying/accepting materials for recycling. WSGS pays \$150/ton to Far West Fibers to accept materials for recycling and \$100/ton to Metro Central Transfer Station for regular garbage. He suggested using

biodegradable waste can liners now that plastic bags are not available from the stores.

Longer term, Mr. Romero said he probably has another two-three years in him to continue operating WSGS and would likely sell to a larger local company rather than an mega-operation like Waste Management.

### **Sunny Workman - Cantastic**

Mr Workman operates the local franchise for Cantastic which provides a service that cleans and sanitizes refuse and recycling containers and dumpsters on location. His crew brought their truck to the West Sylvan MS parking lot and cleaned a trash container as a demo. It looked very clean and had a fresh odor.
