2:00p.m. Call to order by Chair Fagin

2:05 p.m. Chris Ayzoukian gave an update on construction of the PRCA. At this time construction is on schedule with social distancing measures in place.

2:10p.m. Presentation of PRCA lobby artwork from Muse Atelier.

Muse has been working closely with the design and construction project team.

Piece is titled “Puff: Rearview Mirror Ball”. It will be 10 feet across and hang from the lobby ceiling. Mirrors will reflect the colors and images from the lobby and people and ‘invites you onstage.’

Work will have a motion sensor and will spin when triggered by people moving in the lobby.

Lobby floor will include shadow-like images of dandelion seeds – probably stained in concrete.

Pat Reser has seen the proposal and said “I cannot stop smiling.”

Comments from PAC members:

Baker: “Fabulous!”

Fagin- “Gorgeous”

Blaich – “I approve!”

Wilson – “I love that nature is emphasized and I love that people can interact with it.”

Anderson: “I am a fan of things that reflect. I like the contrast between the metal or the piece and the woodwork in the lobby.”

Discussion

Several questions were asked by PAC members. Muse noted that this was their final concept. Staff suggested that the PAC take a vote to recommend this to the BAC.

Baker made a motion to recommend approval of the concept to the BAC.

Blaich seconded.
