Officer Paul Fleckenstein: Beaverton Police Department

- There has been an uptick in thefts..
- At schoolyards, there are more people congregating at night.
- Jails are only taking in higher crimes.
- Safety Center is opening tentatively mid-August.
- Police are making efforts to support Black Lives Matter, so far everything has gone peacefully.

Mark Hokkanen: THPRD

- Opened up Summer camps outdoors.
- Opened up athletic fields.
- Playgrounds remain closed.
- THPRD stands in solidarity with racial equality.
  - Public is invited to paint rocks and put in garden to show support.
- On Fridays, staff and mobile DJ travel to various neighborhoods. (Rockin' the Block).
- Recreation center is opening when phase 2 happens, virtual recreation is online.

Franziska Rose: City Update

- Human Rights Advisory Commission info on website and hosting on YouTube.
- Beaverton supports Black Lives Matter and ethnic diversity, more information on city website.
- City buildings offer services remotely till August 16, all meetings are virtual.
- Returned library materials quarantined for 72 hours.
- Court will open accordingly.
- Real IDs have been postponed for a year.

#### Raziah Roushan: Tualatin Valley Creates & La Strada dei Pastelli Chalk Un-Festival

- 2D4D is an independent organization for the Chalk Art Festival.
- Tualatin Valley Creates
  - A leading arts organization for Washington County.
  - A single comprehensive organization for arts and cultural activities.
  - Provides workshops, runs arts and cultural incubator.
  - Is going ahead with four art installations, plan to have installed in the Fall.
  - Local theaters are doing online performances, more info at the TVC calendar.
  - Follow on social media and watch for virtual events to enjoy.
- La Strada dei Pastelli Chalk Un-Festival
  - The Chalk Art Festival has shut down the physical event for this year.
  - Went virtual (Un-Festival) and created two videos.
  - Un-Festival had 4 artists involved at the Cedar Hill site.
  - The Chalk Art Festival is planning ahead for the Summer of 2021, to be held in front of the new performing arts center.

#### Bill Blair: Community Emergency Response Team (CERT)

- Under FEMA, there are 729 local CERT programs in all 50 states.
- 600,000 trained people.
- 700 CERT officers in Beaverton.
