THE BEAVERTON NIGHT MARKET IS BACK AND IN A NEW LOCATION!

BEAVERTON, Ore. – The Beaverton Night Market will be back in person on Friday, August 13 and Saturday, August 14 from 4 to 10 p.m. The market—now in its seventh year—will take shape in a brand-new location on the streets of downtown Beaverton at SW 1st Street and SW Tucker Avenue.

The location change is due to a longtime desire to bring this event into the streets as is typical of night markets around the world, as well as ongoing construction near The Round as exciting downtown developments continue. Street closures will be in place all day Friday and Saturday to make way for the market, which will operate for two consecutive days.

“Beaverton Night Market is excited to bring you a new perspective to an age-old night market tradition—new set up, new collaborations and a wide array of diverse vendors,” says planning committee member Rehana Malik. “The flexibility of the Night Market committee to adapt to the pandemic has been commendable as we bring back the live, in-person market.”

This family-friendly event will feature a dynamic assortment of more than 40 unique vendors and 20-plus performers representing dozens of cultures from around the world. Two food court areas will feature stages, so attendees can enjoy musical and dance performances while they eat. This year’s market also includes an exciting collaboration with the La Strada dei Pastelli Chalk Art Festival, which will activate three sites with live artists during the market hours.

“Beaverton Night Market represents cultures from all around the world that we have here in Beaverton. No other event so far has been as inviting, inclusive, original, and unique in this city,” says planning committee member Manijeh Mehrnoosh. “It shows that diversity is our strength and through community we find unity. No matter where you’re from, what language you speak, or what culture you are a part of, you are welcome! So what are you waiting for? Beaverton Night Market invites you for two nights of fun, excitement, and friendship!”

The event is free to attend and open to all community members. Since state pandemic restrictions have been lifted, no reservations are necessary for market entry. Attendees are asked to practice good safety protocols and stay home if they are sick.
