Gallery Criteria & Guidelines

- ARTISTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR TRANSPORTING AND HANGING/DISPLAYING
 THEIR WORKS AT BOTH LIBRARY LOCATIONS during normal operating hours
 - All artwork must be compatible with the Arakawa Hanging System or be equipped with a wire across the back in order to comply with the visual art venue hanging systems.
- ☐ Artists are limited in their ability to hang 2-dimensional wall installations in the space—sawtooth hangers, clip frames, single triangle hangers and any hardware systems where the hanging wire does not span the entire length of the back of the artwork are NOT compatible with Arakawa. Beaverton Library – Call to Artists

To best accomplish the goals and objectives of the galleries, all submitted artwork must meet the following criteria and guidelines:

- All artists are encouraged and eligible to apply for these exhibits; however preference will be given to artists currently residing in or creating artwork in a studio in the Washington County area
- Artists are encouraged to visit display spaces prior to submitting images for consideration
- All works must be framed with a wire across the back of the piece.
- Acrylic, unframed works must have wrap around edges of the art work painted
- Exhibits are juried by an art selection panel and work will be selected based on high quality, aesthetic experience and relationship to Gallery Goals, Objectives, Criteria and Guidelines
- Works must be appropriate for an all-age audience
- All 2-Dimensional and 3-Dimensional visual art forms and materials will be considered

Application Guidelines

All applications should be submitted electronically, via email. Please email the following to Kourtnee Buechner at kbuechner@BeavertonOregon.gov:

- Artist bio (no more than 300 words)
- Number of available works for display
- Link to artist website
- 3 JPG Images of artwork meeting Gallery Criteria & Guidelines (which do not exceed 250kb each) that are either the same or substantially similar to what artist plans to display

Submission material will be compiled and reviewed by the library art selection committee monthly.

Exhibit Information

Display periods are two months in length and are dependent upon availability. There is no deadline to apply as display spaces are considered available until filled.

Artwork Sales

Sales of exhibited artwork are permitted and encouraged. All sales inquiries are conducted through Beaverton Library staff. Artists retain 70% of sales generated during and after the exhibition. A 30% commission will be retained on all sales at Beaverton City Libraries.
